These categories have been chosen to reflect some of the best aspects of Boultham Park and are broad enough to be interpreted in a variety of ways.

Entrants can submit one photo under each category heading.

#### PRIZES

The winners from each category will win a London Camera Exchange voucher to the value of £100 and will also be invited to the opening of the exhibition, where a prize giving ceremony will take place.

A further three entries will be shortlisted in each category and will win a photo-themed goodie bag worth  $\pounds 25$  and an invite to the opening of the exhibition.

A special 'Head Judge's Award' of a year's membership to the Lincoln Camera Club and framing to the value of £50 at Speed Frame will also be given to one of the twelve shortlisted entries.

#### RULES

Entrants can submit one photo under each category heading, totalling up to three photos into the competition in all.

Entrants must submit an entry form with their photos.

Entries should be emailed to **boulthampark.project@linkage.org.uk** - this can be done directly or via a WeTransfer link.

Photos should be of a high enough quality so that they can be printed at a minimum size of A3.

Photos should be taken within Boultham Park and between the competition launch date (25th July 2018) and the closing date (2nd September 2018).

All entrants must be amateurs, i.e. not earning a living from taking photographs.

The closing date for entries is 11:59pm on Sunday 2nd September 2018. Entries received after this time will not be considered.

You must be the owner of the copyright of all photos entered and you must agree that the Boultham Park Restoration Project, its partners and funders will take shared copyright of all submitted photographs, however all usage will be credited to the photographer.

Winning and shortlisted photos will be exhibited at various locations, including the Boultham Park Education Centre and within the park during Autumn 2018. They may also be included in a proposed Boultham Park Digital Archive.

It is the entrants responsibility to ensure that all necessary permissions are obtained from people featured in their photo(s).

Consent from a parent/guardian is required for entries from those under the age of 16.

A maximum of three entries per person are allowed, one under each category heading.

The Boultham Park Restoration Project, its partners and funders reserve the right to manipulate the photograph in dimension only for design purposes.

You will be notified by telephone or email if your entry is a winner or is shortlisted.

There will be a prize of a £100 London Camera Exchange voucher for the outright winners of each category and a photo-themed goodie bag worth £25 for the nine shortlisted entries. A further special 'Head Judge's Award' will be given to one of the twelve shortlisted.
